Every year in June, the four days of National Security Seminar is an educational forum for as many as 160 government, business and academic leaders from around the country, joining the senior military and federal representatives who are students of the United States Army War College. These National Security Seminar program participants examine current national security issues and exchange candid dialogue.

Each day generally begins with a distinguished speaker at Bliss Hall and proceeds to seminar-based dialogue, culminating with an evening social event. NSS participants

engage with government and national security leaders, while students in turn are afforded a better understanding of our diverse society.

Self-nominations are not accepted. Selection among the nominees is competitive and intended to heighten the learning opportunity for NSS participants and Army War College students.
