Tuesday was National Voter Registration Day, two weeks before the Oct. 9 deadline to register to vote in the Nov. 6 general election.

With midterm elections coming up and varying voter registration deadlines across states looming in October, the focus of September 25 is on boosting the number of voters eligible to vote in November. This started back in 2012, with organizers boasting over 750,000 voters registering across all 50 states as a result of its 2016 push.

Important Dates for the 2018 Election

- **September 17:** First day to apply for a civilian absentee ballot.
- **October 9:** Last day to register to vote in the November election.
- **October 30:** Last day to apply for a civilian absentee ballot.
- **November 2:** Last day for County Boards of Elections to receive voted civilian absentee ballots.
- **November 6:** General Election.
