

#USAWC students in new Enterprise Management specialization talked change leadership with V/CJCS

On Nov. 5, the Enterprise Management seminar, a new specialization in #USAWC 2022, met with V/CJCS to discuss AI acquisition and payoff.

US Army War College students met with a top military senior leader to discuss a wide-range of topics including, civil-military relations, strategic competition, artificial intelligence, and capability development. At the end, this military officer charged students to lead well into the future.

On Nov. 5, War College students in the Enterprise Management program met with Gen. John Hyten, Vice Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff. He took students' questions and highlighted the students' future roles as change agents within the defense enterprise. Bureaucratic inertia is strong, and the department needs concerted efforts to overcome this inertia, explained Hyten.

The Enterprise Management program is a pilot designed to test concepts of tailorable professional military education. The program delivers three courses in the resident program core curriculum through an enterprise lens, emphasizing decisions and processes at the national, DoD, Joint, and Service levels.

The focus of the seminar is how DoD develops options and provides capabilities to enable warfighters to further national objectives. By intentionally integrating course content, students gain a better understanding for what makes up the Defense enterprise, its purpose, and how it works.
