“Looking at [the USAWC] curriculum, I have already thought of ways I can improve my War Studies class and the way I teach military history. Seeing the seminar format will also help me to reframe my courses.”

He earned his BA from Gettysburg College, his MA from Dartmouth College, and his Ph.D. from the Scottish Center for Wars Studies at the University of Glasgow. His current research is a historical analysis of a British battalion in WWI. His next project will focus on American war memory from Civil War through the War on Terror.
