

## As of March 7 -- Community SitRep -- Manhattan Construction to close of Brook Ave., March 13-15; Garrison Lane will close to through traffic on March 6, 2023

### As of March 7 -- Manhattan Construction to close of Brook Ave., March 13-15

Manhattan Construction Co. will require short-term closures of Brook Ave. to shift the existing perimeter fence and complete work on the new Army War College academic building parking lot and entrance. Currently, Brooke Ave. remains closed to all nonresident traffic.

The Directorate of Public Works, Army Housing Office, and Carlisle Barracks Homes will make every effort to provide residents of Forbes Ave. with advance notice of any closures.

**Currently, the anticipated closure schedule is as follows:**

**March 13-15, 2023**

Manhattan Construction Co. will close Brooke Ave. at the entrance from Wright Ave. to remove the existing perimeter fence on Monday, March 13. Contractors will then install a new curb and patch existing paving.

Upon completion of patchwork, the contractor will reinstall the perimeter fence nearer to the academic building and off Brooke Ave. The fence will remain in this location until work on the new building is complete. This fence relocation will restore full access for Forbes Ave. residents to their garages on Brooke Ave.

Manhattan anticipates this work to be complete and Brooke Ave. to reopen on Wednesday, March 15.

**April 2023: 2–3-day closure – Date to be determined**

In April, Manhattan Construction anticipates a two to three-day closure of Brooke Ave. to mill and repave the road. The specific dates are yet to be determined. The Directorate of Public Works, Army Housing Office, and Carlisle Barracks Homes will share the details of this work when Manhattan finalizes its plan.

Please note both planned Brook Ave. closures depend on the weather and may be subject to change.

Trash collection for all Forbes Ave. residents will continue streetside along Forbes Ave. until the completion of the construction project.

Be cautious when traveling on Carlisle Barracks. Construction vehicles will continue to use Brooke Ave. throughout the construction project. Be sure to follow all signs, directions, and posted speed limits. And remember, children are at play. Slow down, be vigilant, and watch for signs of pedestrians crossing the road.

**As of March 3 -- Garrison Lane will close to through traffic on March 6, 2023**

**Update:** For clarity, the parking spaces along Garrison Lane and across from the United States Post Office will remain open for patron parking.

Carlisle Barracks Community, in a continuous effort to keep our community and neighborhoods safe, the Directorate of Emergency Services will close

Garrison Lane to through traffic beginning on March 6, 2023. The street will remain open to assigned Garrison Lane resident traffic only.

The school-age children's bus stop will move to the Anne Ely parking lot entrance from Garrison Lane on March 6, 2023. The Directorate of Public Works will move the bus stop sign accordingly.

At this time, waste removal will not be affected by this change to traffic flow.

Remember, as we start enjoying the beautiful weather, the installation has a 15-mile-an-hour speed limit for a reason. Our children are at play, and we must ensure their safety. Slow down, be vigilant, and watch for any signs of pedestrians crossing the road.
