Major General Joseph Seelo, Botswana Ground Forces Command Commander, was recently inducted into the U.S. Army War College Hall of Fame on March 2nd, 2023. Seelo graduated from the Army War College in 2013, receiving advanced military education and training in leadership, strategy, and military operations.

"It was ten years ago when I started what is commonly known as the best year of one's life," said Seelo. "A college with an unapparelled reputation of developing critical thinkers who can advance knowledge in the global application of power."

"The War College, founded in 1901, has great warfighters and land power giants among its graduates. With the likes of Gen. George Patton, Gen. Omar Bradley, and Gen. Norman Schwarzkopf, to mention but a few. Therefore, I am proud to have walked the same path these warfighters and strateacists have walked. It is difficult for me to describe the degree of pride

and the amount of respect for having been inducted into the U.S. Army War College's Hall of Fame," said Seelo.

Seelo also has served with the United Nations. Serving in Mozambique and the South African Development Community mission.

The Hall of Fame was established in 1971 and has inducted over 300 international military leaders from 76 countries.
