It will turn left at Marshall Road, continue down, and turn left onto Barry Drive. It will turn right onto LeTort Lane, which becomes Engineer Avenue, and turn hard left onto Flower Road. From Flower Road, it turns right onto Gibner Road and continues on Gibner Road back to the starting point at the intersection of Forbes Avenue and Ashburn Road.
