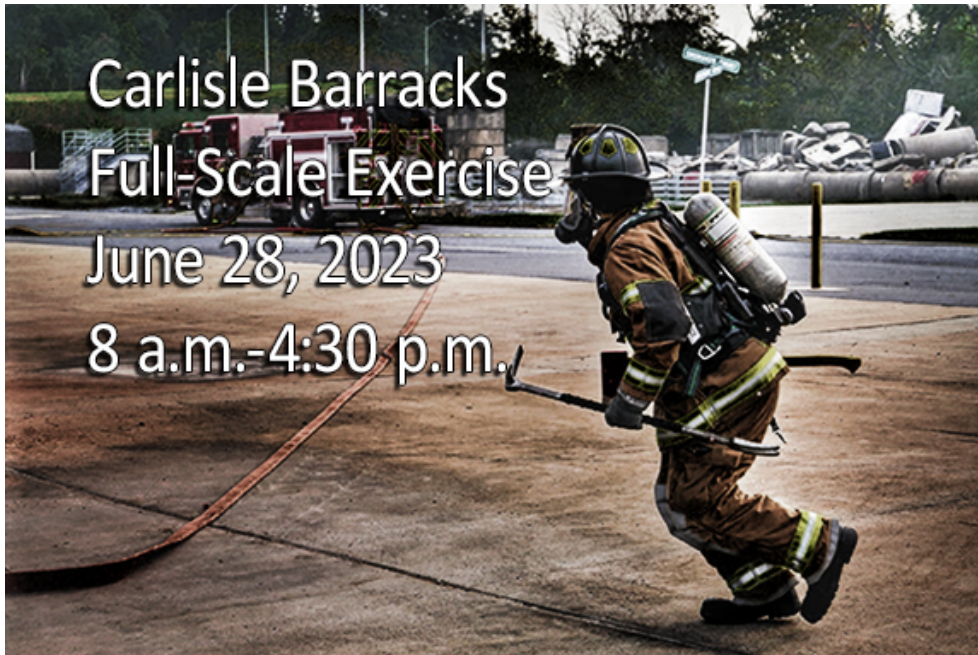


Carlisle Barracks to conduct full scale exercise, June 28, 2023, 8 a.m.to 4:30 p.m.

Carlisle Barracks will conduct its annual installation wide full scale exercise on Wednesday, June 28, 2023, from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Carlisle Barracks will conduct its annual installation-wide full-scale exercise on Wednesday, June 28, 2023, from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The exercise will incorporate aloud, realistic, simulated explosion and an emergency response by Federal, State, and Local authorities.

Technicians will use artificial smoke machines to replicate a resulting fire, and role players and manikins will imitate injured persons.

The exercise will include a closure of Claremont Gate. Installation access will shift to Ashburn Gate for the duration of the training event. Upon completion of the exercise, installation access will revert to Claremont Gate.

Visitors to Carlisle Barracks should expect delays at the gates, closures, and interruptions to all base services during this time. Visitors and patrons are encouraged to visit Carlisle Barracks on a date other than June 28.

The Carlisle Barracks Community should expect disruptions to traffic flow, delays, and a lockdown drill for all building occupants. Community members should follow all signs and directions from emergency personnel.

Post-wide participation will include the Army War College, Army Garrison Carlisle Barracks, Dunham Army Health Clinic, and other post tenants and partners.

Carlisle Barracks' yearly full-scale exercise aims to validate the systems, processes, and reactions needed during a real-world emergency on the installation.
