

Civilian employee retirement benefits briefings set for Sept. 22, 23

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Always wanted to know about your retirement options under CRS or FERS but were afraid to ask? Or you didn't know how to ask? Carlisle Barracks will host two information sessions with an expert from the Army Benefits Center Sept. 22-23 at the LVCC.

Myesha Williams, a human resource expert with the Army Benefits Center at Ft. Riley, Kansas, will present helpful tools and tips for civilian employees planning for retirement and looking at retirement options. Each session will run from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. with an hour for lunch (brown bag or on your own). Employees should only attend the eight-hour session that applies to them. The first day of the session, Tuesday Sept. 22, is focused on employees who will retire under the Civil Service Retirement System. Day two, Wed, Sept. 23, is aimed at employees who fall under the Federal Employee Retirement System.
