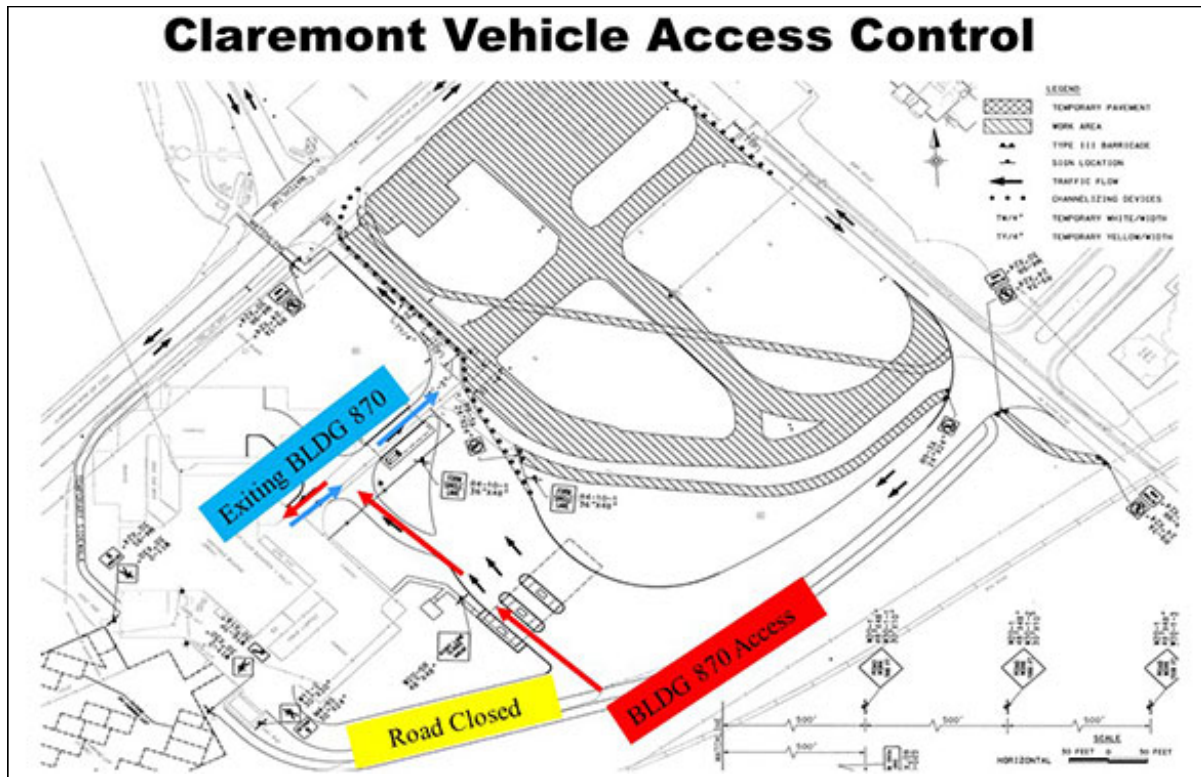


Construction to alter travel to Skills Center, RV lot starting Oct. 19

Construction to alter travel to Skills Center, RV lot starting Oct. 19



Work will begin the week of Oct. 19 on the new Visitors Control Center which will cause some

slight traffic changes for visitors to the Skills Development Center an RV storage lot.

Located at 870 Jim Thorpe Road and adjacent to the Claremont Road entrance to post, the VCC, once complete will serve as the primary entrance point for all post visitors. Visitors will be able to stop in the center, provide proper identification, and get a visitor's pass in order to gain access to the installation. The center and new visitor access changes are being implemented as part of the Homeland Security Presidential Directive #12 directs the Department of Defense to use the National Crime Information Center Interstate Identification Index (NCIC-III) to vet personnel entering the installation that do not possess a U.S. Government Common Access Card (CAC), and/or Uniformed Services Identification (ID) Card.

As part of the initial phase of development, the road currently used to access the building will be closed and the RV lot fence will be under construction for approximately two weeks. During this time, anyone going to the Skills Center will use the visitor lane (far left lane) as the approach the access point and

there will be no access to the RV lot. Those who need access to their RVs or other equipment stored in the lot should call 245-3319 for more information.

The Directorate of Emergency Services will post signage and guards will provide assistance as necessary. Traffic leaving the Skills Center will exit using the road under the canopy.

The VCC is expected to be complete and open for operations later this year.
