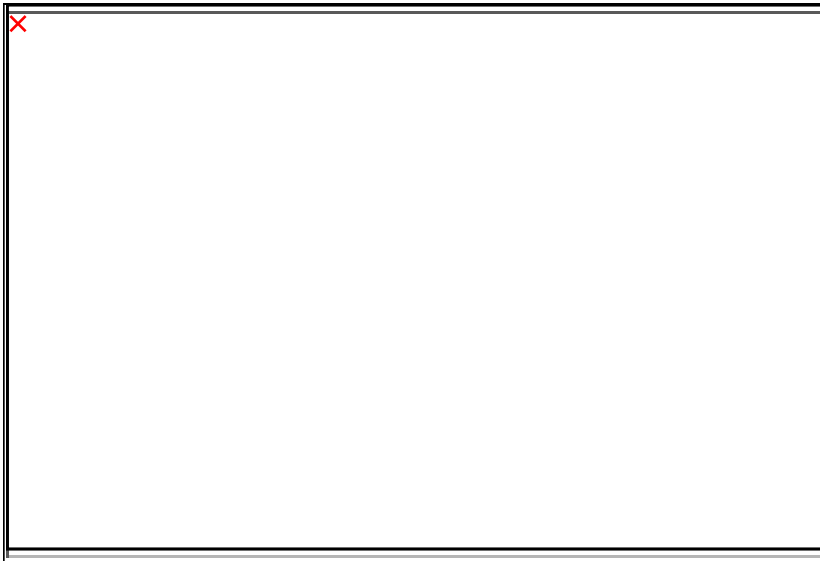


Carlisle Barracks Soldier receives Purple Heart for injuries sustained in Afghanistan
