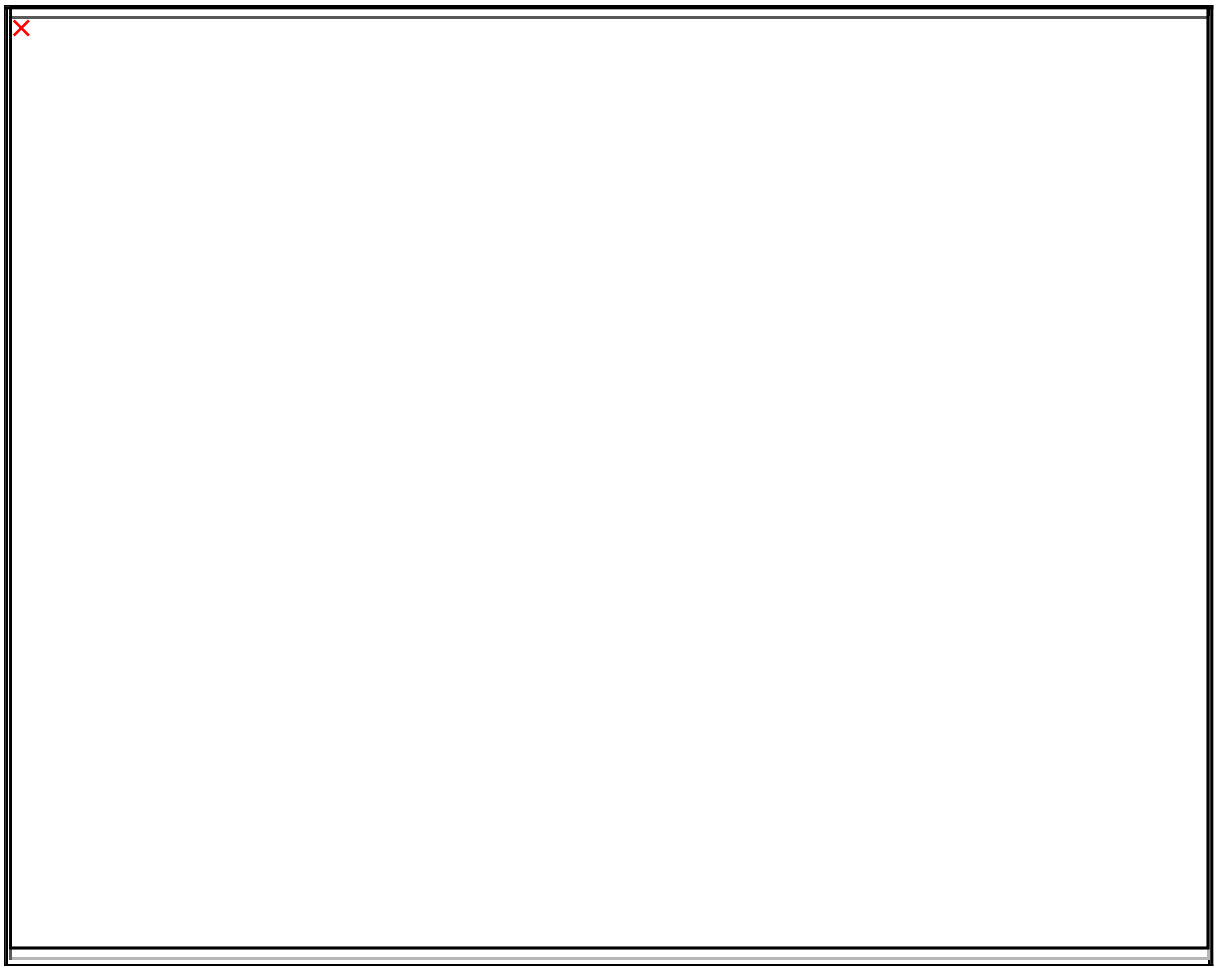


Condolence Statement for Maj. Gen. Greene
