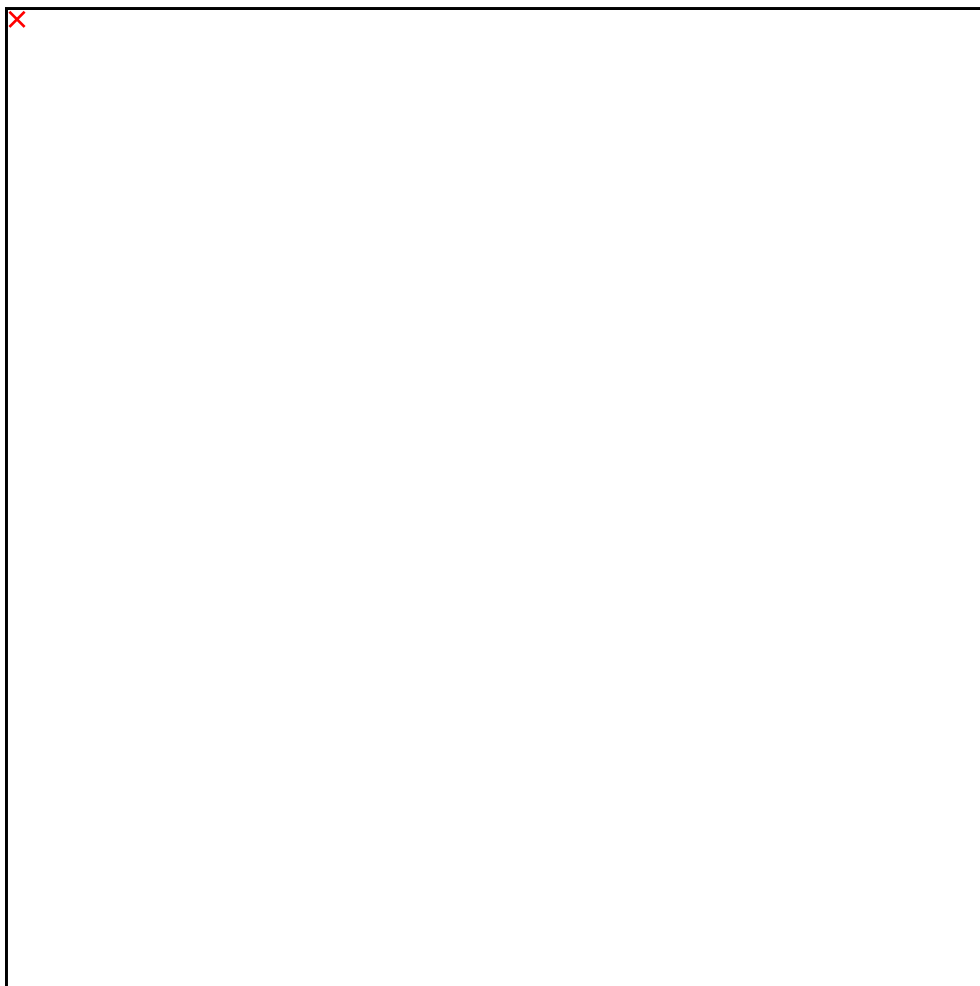


Tax Center now Open
