As the Army transforms, the balance and prioritizing of competing requirements have to be taken into consideration.AFAP assists in identifying the significant issues that face the Army today.In recent years the AFAP program has been restructured to address constrained resources and restrictions on travel and conferences, while still retaining the "voice of the customer" using other methods.

AFAP issues continue to be generated at the grassroots level and elevated to the Army Staff for review and endorsement.Army Staff-endorsed AFAP

issues will be provided to select Army commands where a cross section of stakeholders will prioritize the top issues.

The needs of the Army community remain in the forefront of Army senior leadership.AFAP is the primary tool to communicate the important issues facing Soldiers, civilians, families, survivors, and retirees as the Army transforms in the face of unprecedented budgetary challenges and the impacts of persistent conflict.
