Work has been completed on the new fire alarm and mass notification system at the Moore Child Development Center as part of the post-wide upgrades to these systems. As a result, operations will shift back to the CDC from the McConnell Center.

The upgrades required CDC operations to shift to the McConnell Youth Center, located at 459 Bouquet Road starting last September.

“Thank you all for your support and understanding while we were relocated to the McConnell Youth Center over the last few months,” said Cynthia Burwell, CDC Facility Director.

This new system enables a number of new features for the safety of our children and employees. In addition to providing greater reliability as a new

system, the system provides audible alarms, a direct connection to the Installation Operations Center and the Police desk for communications, a carbon monoxide gas detection and sensors that tell first responders exactly what detector or pull station has been activated, which will save time in the event of an emergency.

The CDC operation hours are 6:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. The phone number to the front desk is 717-245-3701.

Hourly Care will resume on Jan. 14. Hourly Care hours are 8 a.m. – 3:30 p.m., Monday - Friday.
