

Update on lead-based paint at Carlisle Barracks

I wanted to provide you the latest information in regards to possible lead-based paint concerns in Carlisle Barracks homes. We still have no reason to believe there is a lead based paint issue in our homes and continue with actions communicated previously.

Actions conducted since town hall

- USAG Leadership conducted initial review/validation of Balfour Beatty Communities actions, records, work order processes and annual maintenance program
- Conducted water testing in representative homes from each housing area (7 homes in total)- all water samples tested below threshold for lead
- Army Corps of Engineers review of BBC records during the week of Nov. 26
- Army Corps of Engineers team visual inspections of select pre-1978 homes Dec. 17-20.
 - Balfour Beatty will contact residents whose homes will be visually inspected.
- Town Hall meeting after Jan. 1, once results are received from

- USACE records review and visual inspections.
- Follow-on briefings by BBC as necessary.
