UPDATE: Carlisle Barracks, Pa. (Aug. 16, 2019) – Expect intermittent traffic delays at Claremont Gate from 9-11 a.m., Tuesday, Aug. 20 and, Wednesday, Aug. 21. Expect delays in 10-minute increments throughout this time.

The use of Ashburn Gate is highly encouraged for all DoD I.D. Cardholders. Visitors to Carlisle Barracks should continue to process through the Visitors Center located in Bldg. 870, on Jim Thorpe Rd., near the Claremont Gate.

Areas impacted will be Meadows Housing, the Golf Course, Bldg. 870, and Claremont Gate.

PP&L Electric Utilities Company will take down the overhead power lines running along Claremont Rd. as part of their ongoing grid modernization project during this time.

PP&L will be providing their flagger force to control traffic along Claremont and Jim Thorpe Rd.

Bldg. 870 houses the Carlisle Barracks Visitor Center and Skills Development Center.

Continued updates to the ongoing PP&L project will follow.
