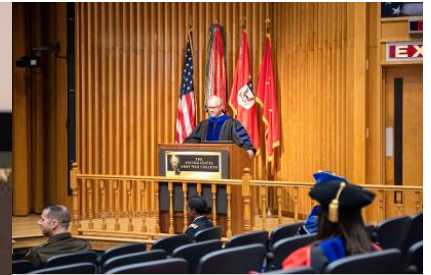


Outstanding Scholarship, Promotions and Department Chairs recognized during Convocation
