CARLISLE BARRACKS, Pa (Sept. 25, 2020) – Individuals entering Carlisle Barracks will require facemasks and should expect slight delays as Carlisle Barracks launches a new Automated Installation Entry system on Monday, Oct. 5, 2020. Training will begin with the new AIE system starting Thursday, Oct. 1.

Guards will wear facemasks and approach within 6 feet of vehicles as they register drivers and all passengers into the AIE system.

Military personnel, Family members, DoD civilians, and retirees may use DoD issued ID cards to access Carlisle Barracks. Guards will scan the back of ID cards to automatically register cardholders into the AIE system, verify information against the DEERS database, and perform a quick

background check.

Persons without a DoD ID Card will process through the Visitor's Center and use a State-issued Driver's License, Passport, or Veterans ID card to gain access, once they have met entry requirements. The Visitor's Center will register all visitors into the AIE system and provide a scannable visitor's pass for Carlisle Barracks entry. The Visitor's Center is open Mon. through Fri., 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
