If there are any spaces available after the older youth are placed, we will place 12 year olds until the course is full. The course will take place over a period of two days from 8 AM to 3:30 PM at the Post Chapel .

The two-day course is being offered twice: Aug. 6-7 and again on Aug. 14-15.

The group will be divided into two groups. Group A will have CPR and First Aid on first day of the training and developmental activities on the second day of the training. Group B will have developmental activities on the first day of the training and CPR and First Aid on the second day of the training. YOU MUST ATTEND BOTH DAYS OF TRAINING TO GET CERTIFIED AS A BABYSITTER AND BE INCLUDED ON THE POST

After successful completion of the full two-day course, which includes several hands-on tests, as well as written exams, your name will be placed on the CYS Babysitter Referral List which is made available for parents affiliated with Carlisle Barracks, both on and off post.
