Deputy chief of staff, G2 to speak at this year's Army War College Graduation Ceremony

The graduation of the class of 2021 will take place Friday, July 23, at 9 a.m. on the historic parade field of Carlisle barracks. Lt. Gen. Laura A. Potter will address the 382 students, including 306 U.S. Army officers, 24 Air Force, 4 Navy, 9 Marines, 32 senior federal civilians, and 7 international officers.

All are invited to view the entire ceremony as it is streamed live at www.armywarcollege.edu/live, starting at 9 a.m. The ceremony is closed to the public, with the attendance limited to graduating students, their guests,

and faculty.

Students will be recognized for having earned the Master's degree in Strategic Studies, USAWC diploma, and Joint Professional Military Education-Level 2 certification -- as well as for the future contributions that they will make to the security of their countries. The ceremony will recognize those students who earned special writing honors and faculty who have earned honors in teaching excellence.

At approximately 9 a.m., the 108th Field Artillery from the Pa. Army National Guard will fire an honorary artillery salute. Ceremonial music will be provided by the Carlisle Town Band, and War College Professor Bert Tussing will sing the National Anthem.

Lt. Gen. Potter became the Deputy Chief of Staff, G-2, in Sept. 2020. She is also a 1989 graduate of Dickinson College. Potter's most recent assignment was as the commanding general of the United States Army Intelligence Center of Excellence. She holds bachelor's degrees in Russian and Spanish from Dickinson College, a master's degree from Georgetown University's School of Foreign Service, Center for Eurasian, Russian, and East European Studies, and a master's in national security and strategic studies from the Naval War College.

- Enter Carlisle Barracks at the Claremont Road Visitor Gate @ 870 Jim Thorpe Road, Carlisle 17013 (DoD ID cardholders, only, can use the Route 11 gate)
- Special Event signs and security police will direct drivers to parking lots.
- A shuttle service will rotate through parking lots from 7 to 9 a.m. and again following the ceremony. On-base residents are encouraged to use the shuttle.
- Parking attendants will direct drivers to handicapped parking, and disability seating is available at Quarters 2.
- Water will be provided. No coolers please

A shuttle will be rotating between 7 to 9 a.m. (and following the ceremony) between the parking areas on post and the parade ground. Students who live on base are encouraged to park at home and use the shuttle bus.

If you are driving yourself, enter Carlisle Barracks at the visitor's entrance, Claremont Gate. For navigation, please enter the 870 Jim Thorpe Rd., Carlisle, PA 17013, and follow the signs to the vehicle access point, and then follow Special Event signs. Security police and parking attendants will assist.
