

As of Nov. 23 - Ashburn Gate to close for Thanksgiving, Nov. 23, 5:30 p.m. through Nov. 27, 6:30 a.m.

Ashburn Gate will close in observance of the Thanksgiving Holiday on Wednesday, November 23, at 5:30 p.m. and remain closed through Monday, November 27, at 6:30 a.m.

As of Nov. 16 -- The Directorate of Plans, Training, Mobilization and Security will conduct their monthly outdoor-only test of the emergency mass notification system, the "Giant Voice," today, November 16, between 1 and 1:30 p.m.

As of Nov. 15 -- Expect minimal delays at Claremont Gate, Nov. 15-18, after 6 p.m.

Carlisle Barracks Community, expect minimal delays at Claremont Gate after 6 p.m. Nov. 15 through Nov. 18 as contractors perform routine maintenance. Flaggers will direct traffic as needed. Please follow all signs, directions, and speed limits when traveling on Carlisle Barracks.

Nov. 9 -- Ashburn Gate will close in observance of the Veterans Day Holiday

Ashburn Gate will close in observance of the Veterans Day Holiday on Thursday, Nov. 10, at 5:30 p.m. The gate will reopen on Monday, Nov. 14, at 6:30 a.m.

As of Oct. 19 -- Letort Ln. to close for paving, Oct. 31-Nov. 4, 2022

Letort Ln. will close for road paving from Barry Dr. to Butler Rd. on Monday, October 31, at 6:30 a.m. It will remain closed to all traffic until paving is complete on Friday, November 4, 2022.

The Carlisle Barracks Community can access and exit Collins Hall, the Bowling Center, Veterinary Clinic, and Bldg. 632 from Forbes Ave., using Barry Dr., Marshall Rd., and Butler Rd.

Drivers may experience brief delays at Letort Ln. and Butler Rd. when workers excavate and pave the intersection. A flagger force will provide traffic control at this time.

Be mindful of children playing, two-way traffic, and obey posted speed limits at all times.

Residents along Marshall Rd. are encouraged to park off the street to improve visibility and facilitate the increase in two-way traffic.

Sept. 21 -- The Directorate of Plans, Training, Mobilization, and Security will conduct their monthly test of the emergency mass notification system, the "Giant Voice," today, September 21, between 1 and 1:30 p.m.

Sept. 20 -- Expect minimal delays at Claremont Gate Sept. 20, after 6 p.m. as workers perform routine barrier maintenance.

Sept. 6 -- Power outage to impact Collins Hall, ASEP, Ed Center, Bowling Center Thursday, Sept. 8, noon-8 p.m.

A planned power outage will affect Collins Hall, Bldg. 650, the Army Strategic Education Program and Education Center, Bldg. 632, and the Strike Zone Bowling Center, Bldg. 686, on Thursday, September 8, 2022, from noon to 8 p.m.

Contractors will conduct the planned outage in support of the Army War College's New Academic Building Project.

Aug. 19 -- Contractors to perform maintenance on Claremont Gate, Aug. 22-25

The Carlisle Barracks Community should expect minimal delays at Claremont Gate from Aug. 22 to Aug. 25, as contractors perform maintenance on the barriers at the installation access point.

A flagger force will be on-site to direct traffic as needed.

Please follow all signs, directions, and speed limits when traveling on Carlisle Barracks.

Aug. 4 -- Army Heritage Drive to close for railroad crossing replacement, Aug. 15-19

Army Heritage Drive will close for the replacement of the Norfolk Southern railroad crossing beginning Monday, August 15, 2022. It will reopen on Friday, August 19, 2022.

A detour will direct traffic east on Claremont Road, south on South Middlesex Road, west onto Trindle Road, and vice versa.

Drivers who routinely use Army Heritage Drive when traveling to or from Carlisle Barracks should plan their schedules accordingly, keeping in mind the detour and the potential for increased traffic on these roads.

Personnel and patrons can continue to access the United States Army Heritage and Education Center from the Trindle Road side of Army Heritage Drive.

July 29 -- Ashburn Gate to close on weekends starting July 30

Ashburn Gate will close on weekends until further notice starting on Saturday, July 30, 2022. The gate will close on Fridays at 5:30 p.m. and reopen on Mondays at 6:30 a.m.

Ashburn Gate hours starting July 30, 2022:

July 29 -- Contractors to paint barriers at Ashburn, Claremont Gates, Aug. 1-5

The Carlisle Barracks Community should expect minimal delays at Ashburn and Claremont gates from August 1 to August 5 as contractors work to paint the barriers at the installation access points.

The painting will occur at Ashburn Gate no earlier than 5:30 p.m. and at Claremont Gate no earlier than 6:30 p.m.

A flagger force will be on-site to direct traffic as needed.

Please follow all signs, directions, and speed limits when traveling on Carlisle Barracks.

July 29 -- Carlisle Barracks to experience a brief power outage on Aug. 2, at 5:30 a.m.

Carlisle Barracks will experience a brief power outage on Tuesday, August 2, at 5:30 a.m. when the Directorate of Public Works switches Carlisle Barracks back from alternate power feeds. This power outage will not impact facilities at the United States Army Heritage and Education Center or the Carlisle Barracks MWR Golf Course.

July 24 -- UPDATE: Planned Power Outage on Carlisle Barracks, July 25, 5 to 5:30 a.m. -- POSTPONED

UPDATE: The planned power outage on Carlisle Barracks on July 25, 2022, from 5 to 5:30 a.m. has been POSTPONED. The Directorate of Public Work will reschedule the outage for a later date.

Carlisle Barracks will experience brief power outages when the Directorate of Public Works switches Carlisle Barracks' power to and from alternate feeds on July 22 and July 25, 2022, from 5 to 5:30 a.m. These planned outages will allow DPW to perform annual preventive maintenance on the Carlisle Barracks' electrical sub-station. DPW technicians will perform building checks on July 22 and 25 to ensure all heating, ventilation, and air conditioning systems are operating properly.

The complete schedule is as follows:

July 22, 5-5:30 a.m. -- Switch to alternate feeds, brief power outage

July22 through 24 -- DPW will perform preventative maintenance on Carlisle Barracks' sub-station

July 25, 5-5:30 a.m. -- Switch back to sub-station feeds, brief power outage, return to normal operations

July 7 -- Parking closed in front of Bliss Hall along Forbes Ave., July 11 through 13

The Directorate of Emergency Services will close the six parking spaces in

Directorate of Public Works will repair the underground water main along Forbes Ave. during this period.

This water main repair will cause intermittent water outages to Bliss Hall and Root Hall in the afternoon of July 11, and the morning of July 12.

July 4 -- Brooke Ave. closed July 5, through July 7, 2022

Carlisle Barracks' Department of Emergency Services will close Brooke Ave. to all through traffic and parking from July 5 through July 7, 2022. Manhattan Construction Co. will relocate and extend the fencing along Brooke Ave during this period.

Effective July 8, Brooke Ave. will open to assigned residents only.

The road will remain closed to traffic until the completion of the new Army War College academic building project.

June 16 -- Letort Lane closure starting June 16 through July 22, 2022

Letort Lane will close from Ashburn Bridge to Barry Drive starting June 16 through July 22, 2022.

The closure will permit contractors to install new utility lines for Root Hall Gym.

May 27 -- Commissary extends Sunday shopping hours starting June 19, 2022

Starting June 19, 2022, the Commissary will open to shoppers on Sundays from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.
