## Students travel to NYC for annual staff ride

"This staff ride offers an extremely valuable experiential learning opportunity that builds powerfully on what the students are learning in the classroom, especially in the areas of strategic leadership, diplomacy, economics, and information operations," said Wilson.

During the staff ride, students also network with these leaders. "It is always important for senior leaders that are entering into the strategic level to better connect with the society that they serve, and the NSSR allows for that interaction to occur," said Robert Mundell, NYC Event Coordinator.

The Army War College curriculum supplements in-class learning with experiential learning by bringing students on multiple staff rides. Other staff rides include a trip to Washington D.C. and another to Gettysburg which they did earlier in the year.
