### **As of June 1 -- New Army War College Academic Building fire alarm**

**testing tomorrow, June 2, starting at 8 a.m.**

Carlisle Barracks Community, contractors will conduct audibility testing of the fire alarm system at the new Army War College Academic Building tomorrow, June 2, 2023, starting at about 8 a.m. The exterior fire alarm speakers will play the emergency notification during testing and throughout the day. Residents and personnel near the building should be aware they may hear the announcement related to system testing.

**As of May 18 -- Sidewalk repairs on Carlisle Barracks, May 22-June 2, 2023**

Carlisle Barracks Community, be aware a contractor will repair several sidewalks around the Garrison starting May 22, 2023. The Directorate of Public Works expects work to be complete by June 2.

The community can expect minimal impacts and sidewalk closures during this time behind Upton Hall, near the Moore Child Development Center, the Exchange, and along Jim Thorpe Rd.

**May 12 -- Parking lot along Letort Ln., Letort Ln. and Pratt Ave. intersection to close May 17, 7 a.m.-noon**

The Directorate of Public Works will close the parking lot along Letort Ln. and the intersection of Letort Ln. and Pratt Ave. to all vehicle and pedestrian traffic in order to perform crane operations and remove the pedestrian bridge on the morning of Wednesday, May 17, 2023, from 7 a.m. to noon.

The road will be closed to vehicle and pedestrian traffic during this time. DPW expects the HVAC work to be complete by noon.

**April 19, 2023 -- Brooke Ave. will close for repaving, April 24 through

Carlisle Barracks' Department of Emergency Services will close Brooke Avenue to all through traffic and parking from April 24 through April 28 as Manhattan Construction mills and repaves the road. This planned closure is weather-dependent and subject to change.

Once the maintenance work is complete, Brooke Avenue will reopen to all through traffic and parking in designated spaces.

**April 18, 2023 -- JTSD Cycling Race Saturday, April 22, 2023, 7 a.m.**

Residents who live along the route should remove vehicles from the street on Friday night, April 21. This will allow officials to clean the roads and ensure rider safety during the event. Residents can park their vehicles in driveways, garages, or the Collins Hall and Anne Ely parking lots.

The race will affect the following roads: Forbes Avenue, Liggett Road, Butler Road, LeTort Lane, Marshall Road, Flower Road, and Gibner Road. On race day, these roads will be closed to all traffic from 6:45 to 8:15 a.m. Set-up for the race will begin at 6 a.m.

The roadways will reopen when the race is complete at about 8:15 a.m.

The starting point for the race will be at the intersection of Forbes Avenue and Ashburn Drive, across from the Fire Station. The race will proceed down Forbes Avenue, in front of Young Hall, and then turn right onto Liggett Road. From Liggett Road, it will turn left onto Butler Road until it reaches Marshall Road. It will turn left at Marshall Road, continue down, and turn left onto Barry Drive. It will turn right onto LeTort Lane, which becomes Engineer Avenue, and turn hard left onto Flower Road. From Flower Road, it turns right onto Gibner Road and continues on Gibner Road back to the starting point at the intersection of Forbes Avenue and Ashburn Road.
