By embracing diplomacy and strategic communication, participants learn to defuse tensions and forge meaningful solutions, preparing them for real-world scenarios where

collaboration is essential.

"Our biggest thing is outreach" said Zukowski, Director of the International Strategic Crisis Negotiation Exercise Program. "To show a side of the military that these students have never seen, but also when they get into those positions of working in an embassy or maybe an NGO, the first time that they come in contact with the United States military, we don't want that to be in a hostile situation or a situation where the military is being used," he said.
