



# Executive Leadership Development Course -Spouse (ELDC-S)

ELDC-S is a specific USAWC academic course offered as part of the institution's enterprise-executive leadership development education program. It incorporates many of the offerings in the MFP menu, but is a specific academic certificate program. ELDC-S educates and develops Senior Spouse leaders for service at the senior-enterprise level to include advancing knowledge through graduate-level education and training in senior leadership skills and practices. With some focus on development and issues related to military communities and related activities and policies, the course focuses mainly on executive The ELDC-S Certificate Program is to provide USAWC student spouses with graduate-level education and training in various senior leadership and family-care areas

## Course Learning Objectives:

1. Analyze the unique aspects of leadership required at the senior-enterprise level.
2. Evaluate the role of the senior-enterprise (spouse) leader in assessing organizations, recognizing if or where change may be needed and collaborating with others to improve the organization, to support individual development and to achieve improved results.
3. Evaluate the role of senior-enterprise (spouse) leader to act ethically and promote the values and ethics of the profession as a representative of the military.
4. Convey complex information and communicate effectively and persuasively to any audience.
