SUBJECT: Command Policy #20 -- Carlisle Barracks Access Control Policy Regarding Tours and Large Groups

FÈ This policy applies to all guided tours and groups of 20 persons or greater requestingÁ access onto Carlisle Barracks.

œ Persons requesting access to Carlisle Barracks (CBks) are required to undergo aÁ background check through the National Crime Information Center (NCIC) prior to beingÁ given a visitor's access control pass. Information on disqualifying criminal offenses canÁ be found on the Carlisle Barrack● Visitor's Center website, https://www.armywarcollege.edu/visitorcenter/visitors.cfm.

HÈ Individuals requesting access must submit a CBks Form 228 to the CBks Visitor'sÁ Center no less than 14 days prior to their arrival. The CBks Form 228 can be found onÁ the Visitor's Center website, <u>https://www.armywarcollege.edu/visitorcenter/</u>.
